**Sub: Filling up 25% Posts of Scientist – B in ICMR through Limited
Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE)**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that in order to fill up 25% posts of Scientist-B in the PB-3 of Rs. 15600-39100 + Rs.5400 through Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) the following guidelines have been drawn up :-

Guidelines for conducting Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) to fill the post of Scientist-B in ICMR:-

1. (a) Eligibility for LDCE – As defined under para 7 (a) (d) and (e) of the Health Research Scientists Cadre of Indian Council of Medical Research Rules, 2007, the technical staff with Second Class Post Graduate Qualification having five years experience in the grade pay of Rs.4200/- and above are eligible for the written test.

(b) Frequency of LDCE - The examination shall be held once in a year or if required, more than once in a year. It shall consist of a written test and an interview.

(c) Venue- The venue of the examination shall be at New Delhi.

(d) Roster – First post of Scientist-B, falling vacant shall be filled by LDCE and next three posts of Scientist- B may be filled by Direct Recruitment (DR). The roster for LDCE (both for reservation for SCs and STs and also between DR and LDCE) would be maintained centrally at ICMR Hqrs.

2. Directors/Officer-in-Charges will be required to indicate the field of specialization at least one year in advance in which the post of Scientist-B is to be filled through LDCE. For this year it may be informed immediately latest by 20th Dec., 2010. The tentative date for written examination would be March, 2011.

3. The selection shall be based on the following criteria:

(i) Past Experience: 30%

Based on number of years of service, contribution to major projects and publications – partially or fully.

(ii) Written examination – 40%

Will be further distributed as follows:-

- o 15% on general biological knowledge,
- o 10% for elementary bio-medical knowledge and;
- o 15% for the specialization for which the post is being filled up;


(iii) Interview – 30% -

The candidates who qualify based on the marks in the written test and past experience shall be called for interview at ICMR Hqrs., New Delhi. Selection shall be on the basis of merit and number of vacancies available. No waiting list would be prepared.

4. Relaxation for SC /ST candidates shall be provided as per DOPT guidelines. Further, exceptionally meritorious technical staff shall be given relaxation in qualification, experience and age as per HRSC Rules, 2007 on the work performance, written exam and interview as per recommendation of Selection Board.
5. The selected candidates will not be considered for further future promotion by merit assessment until & unless they have completed Ph.D.
6. The syllabus for written examination would cover the three areas mentioned in **Para - 3 (ii) i.e. biology, elementary biomedical knowledge and the areas of specialization** (*further details of the syllabus would be circulated shortly*), for which the post is being filled up.

It is requested to bring the above mentioned guidelines to the notice of all concerned by putting guidelines copy on Notice Board of the Institute/Centre.
